

## **9YO, 10YO, 11/12YO Call Notes – Zoom Call held on 03/01 at 8:00PM**

Made brief comments on equipment pickup and uniform pickup. Shared that player and coach shirts would be ready around 03/17.

We had some discussion on the rules. This [link](#) will take you to the 9/10YO rules page, and this [link](#) will take you to the 11/12YO rules page. We encouraged coaches to review the pitcher's section of the rules. Gamechanger will help you in tracking pitch counts for your pitchers. The one game limit for 9-10YOs is 75 and 85 for 11/12YOs.

Weather will be a factor during the season. You can find more information regarding our weather policy at this [link](#). There are three ways we will provide updates regarding cancellations. The first notice of a closing occurs via X (formerly Twitter) from “@BWood\_Ball\_Club”. We will update the fields status section on our website which you will find on the home page. We will also send an email blast to all participants to notify of closing.

When playing games at Civitan, warmups are to occur in the outfield to preserve the infield dirt. For games occurring on turf, we will adjust the base and mound distances so that they are correct. For any practices on turf, you will need to make those adjustments. This [link](#) will show you the correct distances for the bases. For the mounds, a good rule of thumb is making sure the pitching rubber is directly in between 1B and 3B to get the mound at about the correct distance for each age group. Mound distances are 46' for 9/10YO and 50' for 11/12YO.

Throughout the season, you will have the field lights on for your practices at some point. Both Civitan and Crockett Park lights are controlled by an app, so there is no light box or switch to turn on the lights. If other fields have lights come on and your field does not, that would be a good time to text either one of us to get the lights on for your field. Both of our cell numbers are listed below.
